

## NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 31st December, 2008

S.O. 3007(E).—Whereas, the Central Government, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 27 of the Insecticides Act, 1968 (46 of 1968) published a draft Order for declaring its intention to prohibit the manufacture, import and use of Chlorofenvinphos *vide* notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Agriculture and Cooperation) number S.O. 1793 (E), dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2007 and invited objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby, till the expiry of a period of forty five days from the date on which copies of the Official Gazette in which the said notification was published were made available to the public;

And whereas, copies of the said Gazette were made available to the public on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 2007;

And whereas, no objections and suggestions were received from the public in respect of the said draft Order;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 27 read with section 28 of the Insecticides Act, 1968 (46 of 1968), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order, namely:-

## ORDER

1. This Order may be called the Banning of Chlorofenvinphos Order, 2008.
2. No person shall manufacture, import and use Chlorofenvinphos.
3. The Registration Committee shall call back the certificates of registration granted for Chlorofenvinphos from all registrants including new registrants.
4. If any person who holds the certificate of registration fails to return the certificate to the Registration Committee, referred to in clause (3), within a period of six months, action shall be taken under section 14 of the said Act.
5. Every State Government shall take all such steps under the provisions of the said Act and the rules made thereunder, as it considers necessary for the execution of this Order in the State.
