

DECIDES:

Article 1.- To permit the exceptional registration of 05 drugs (including 02 insecticides, 01 yellow snail killer, 01 growth stimulants and 01 adjuvant) into the list of plant protection drugs permitted for use in Vietnam (list enclosed herewith).

Article 2.- The import and export of plant protection drugs in the list issued together with this Decision shall comply with Circular No. 62/2001/TT-BNN of June 5, 2001 of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development guiding the import and export of goods subject to agricultural specialized management under the Prime Minister's Decision No. 46/2001/QD-TTg of April 4, 2001 on the management of goods import and export in the 2001-2005 period and Decision No. 145/2002/QD-BNN of December 18, 2002 of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development.

Article 3.- This Decision takes effect 15 days after its publication in the Official Gazette.

The Plant Protection Department shall have to provide detailed guidance on safe and efficient use of these above-stated plant protection drugs.

Article 4.- The director of the Ministry's Office, the director of the Plant Protection Department, the director of the Science and Technology Department, the heads of units under the Ministry, domestic organizations and individuals and foreigners managing, producing, trading in, and using plant protection drugs in Vietnam shall have to implement this Decision.
