



# Adding Substances to Schedule 1 of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*

Three substances in this batch were proposed to be added to <u>Schedule 1</u>.

### Reduced Regulatory Requirement (RRR) Polymer Criteria

Two substances in this batch meet the Reduced Regulatory Requirements (RRR) polymer criteria as specified in the Reduced Notification Regulations (NSNR). Therefore, it is recommended that the Domestic Substances List (DSL) be amended to indicate that these substances meet the RRR polymer criteria (apply a Pr flag). Should other forms of these polymers, not meeting the RRR polymer criteria, be introduced on the Canadian market, those polymers would be considered not listed on the DSL, and subject to the requirements of the NSNR. One Order has been published.

### Final Screening Assessment and Risk Management Approaches

In September 2011, the final screening assessment reports for this batch were released. Notices relating to this release were published in the <u>Azette</u>, Part I: Vol. 145, No. 37 - <u>September 10, 2011</u> (<u>PDF Version - 1147 K</u>).

The final screening assessment concluded that three substances in this batch meet one or more criteria in section 64 of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999* (CEPA 1999). The Government proposed to add these substances to Schedule 1 of the Act. In addition, one of these substances, (CAS No. 68412-48-6) has been found to meet the criteria for <u>virtual elimination</u> under subsection 77(4) of the Act, and therefore is being proposed for addition to the <u>Virtual Elimination List</u>. Proposed risk management approach documents were also released on this date for the substances in this batch which met the criteria in section 64 of CEPA 1999.

### **Draft Screening Assessment Reports and Risk Management Scopes**

New information was received from industry or interested stakeholders for each of the 16 substances in this batch. In October 2010, the draft screening assessment reports were released and the related Notices were published in the <a href="#">Mainterest Canada Gazette</a>, Part I: Vol. 144, No. 40 - October 2, 2010 ( PDF Version - 1571 K). Risk management scope documents were also released in conjunction with these publications.

Comments and the Government's response relating to general themes on the draft screening assessment reports and risk management scope documents are summarized in the <u>Summary of Overarching Public Comments received on the Draft Screening Assessment Reports and Risk Management Scope on the Challenge substances in Batch 11.</u>

### **Launch of Batch 11 and Submissions Received**

Information on substances in this batch was gathered from industry and interested stakeholders through a mandatory survey Notice issued under section 71 of CEPA 1999. They were also invited to complete a voluntary questionnaire.

A Notice related to the launch of Batch 11 was published in September 2009 in the *Canada Gazette*. The section 71 Notice applied to all 16 substances in this batch.
