

PRODUCT SAFETY IN BURUNDI

The Republic of Burundi is one of the eight countries that form part of the East African Community (EAC) which also includes the Democratic Republic of Congo, Kenya, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda

EAC Standards and Technical Regulations are generally adopted by the regulatory agencies of all member states as national legislation. However, in some cases, national governments may set their own requirements in the form of ministerial decrees, regulations, and/or standards. The adoption of a standard is announced on the [Burundi Standards](#) site or through the WTO.

In addition to national legislation found under the *Module: Product Safety*, Burundi enforces EAC regulations and standards as well. Please check for this topic under *Country: East African Community*.
