**SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO FDA ADVISORY NO. 2025-0509
ENTITLED, "REGULATORY UPDATES FOR
HOUSEHOLD/URBAN HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES
(HUHS)"**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA), through the Center for Cosmetics and Household/Urban Hazardous Substances Regulation and Research (CCHUHSRR), is undertaking the necessary processes to formalize an administrative issuance that will further enhance regulatory frameworks and systems to improve its efficiency and effectiveness, and address the appeals and regulatory challenges posed by the household/urban hazardous substances (HUHS) industry. It is thus in the exigency of service that further regulatory flexibilities in the registration and labeling requirements for HUHS products are hereby issued.

All concerned stakeholders are hereby informed that the transitory period for the mandatory Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) for HUHS products and its labeling requirements under Annex J of FDA Circular 2020-025 will be further extended **until 30 June 2026**, unless otherwise repealed or amended.

Relatedly, the extension of HUHS licensing validity in accordance with FDA Advisory No. 2025-0512-A is herein reiterated. Such extension remains effective until the formal announcement of the completion of the ongoing HUHS data migration.

All other stakeholders, including the Bureau of Customs, are requested to consider the above-mentioned regulatory flexibilities relevant for the release of shipments of HUHS products.

This advisory supersedes the relevant provisions of FDA Advisory 2025-0509. For the information and guidance of all concerned HUHS stakeholders.
