Plant Quarantine Rules and Regulations of Bhutan 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred to the Ministry of Agriculture and Forests (MoAF) under Section 6 of the Plant Quarantine Act of Bhutan, 1993, the Minister hereby adopts this Rules and Regulations.

CHAPTER I PRELIMINARY

Title and Commencement

- 1. This Rules and Regulations shall be called the Plant Quarantine Rules and Regulations of Bhutan 2018.
- 2. It shall come into force from the date specified in the notification issued by the Minister.

Repeal

3. This Rules and Regulations repeals the Plant Quarantine Rules of Bhutan, 2003 and all prior notifications issued there under.

Implementing Agency

4. In accordance with Section 6(b) of the Act, the MoAF hereby designates Bhutan Agriculture and Food Regulatory Authority (BAFRA) as an implementing agency for the purpose of implementing the provisions of this Rules.

- 7. The MoAF may designate additional quarantine stations and any other point of entry as and when required through a public notification.
- 8. Any plant, plant product, package, goods and soil subject to quarantine shall be imported into Bhutan only through the officially declared point of entry as provided in Rule 6 of this Rules.
- 9. Where a plant, plant product, package, goods and soil believed to be infested or infected with a quarantine pest or disease, it shall be withheld at the point of entry for quarantine or may be seized and destroyed.
- 10. Any person who removes a plant, plant product, package, goods and soil withheld under Rule 9 of this Rules, without the written authority of an inspector shall be liable for a fine as per Rule 58 of this Rules.

CHAPTER III IMPORT

General Procedure

- (5) In the event, the application is for the import of non-released varieties, the field office shall submit the application to the head office for further assessment, who shall then forward the application to the Variety Release Committee (VRC) for technical advice within two working days and communicate the decision of the VRC to the field office or applicant at the earliest.
- (6) Import permit issued under this Rules shall be valid for the period of three months.

- 15. All imports shall be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate (PSC) from the exporting country, with endorsements as necessary, packed free of soil in an approved packing material as provided under Schedule III. The consignment upon arrival shall be declared at the point of entry and comply with the following phytosanitary requirements:
 - (a) To be inspected for regulated pests, signs and symptoms of pest and disease, or organism for which phytosanitary risks are not determined.
 - (b) If necessary a representative sample may be drawn for examination from the consignment and conduct test for postentry quarantine decision.
 - (c) Affected products may be removed by sorting and reconfiguring the consignment including packaging.
 - (d) Conduct treatment for required duration at the appropriate station and analysis by relevant agencies at the cost of importer.
 - (e) Consignment with quarantine pest or disease or associated quarantine risk shall be detained for removal at the cost of importer upon serving detention notice.

Import of fresh fruits and vegetables

- 21. In accordance with Section 5(1) (c), and Section 5(2) of the Act, the import of fresh fruits and vegetables into Bhutan shall require an import permit from BAFRA as per Schedule II.

No permit shall be required for the import of dried, frozen, processed or candied fruits and vegetables, if such fruits and vegetables are unsuitable for propagation or innocuous as pest carriers. Import permit requirement for such products shall be in compliance with the Food Rules and Regulations of Bhutan, 2017 or any other applicable laws.

CHAPTER IV EXPORT

CHAPTER V INTERNAL QUARANTINE

- 43. In accordance with Section 5(1)(b), the Ministry hereby authorize BAFRA to declare any district or area infested or infected with quarantine pest and disease for the internal quarantine.
- 44. BAFRA shall impose internal quarantine upon the receipt of notification from the concerned authority.
- 45. BAFRA in collaboration with concerned authority shall carry out Pest Risk Analysis (PRA) and develop Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the purpose of internal quarantine.
- 46. BAFRA shall issue in-country movement permit at the designated checkpoint of quarantine area upon inspection and treatment of the consignment, if required.
- 47. BAFRA shall issue in-country movement permit for movement of consignment upon inspection at the entry or exit point that is to be transported to various regions in the country.

CHAPTER VI FINES AND PENALTIES

Civil offence

- 48. In accordance with Section 6(a) of the Act, the following contravention of this Rule shall be an offence liable for payment of fines.
- 49. Illegal import of plant, plant product, seed and soil with quarantine risk shall result in seizure and destruction with warning for a first offence. The violation for the second time and beyond shall be liable to a fine of Nu. 100 per plant/1 kg of plant product/10 gm of seed/1gm of soil and the consignment shall be seized and destroyed without any compensation to the violator.
- 50. Encounter of consignment infested with quarantine pest shall result in seizure and destruction at the cost of the importer or the consignment shall be treated for removal of quarantine pest before release at the cost of the importer.
- 51. Import of wood with quarantine risk shall result in seizure and destruction or transport back to the exporting country at the cost of the importer with warning for a first offence. The violation for second time shall be liable for Nu.100 per cubic feet and such consignment shall be seized and destroyed or transport back to the exporting country at the cost of the importer.

- 52. Failure to declare any consignment with required documents at the point of entry shall be served with a written warning for the first time and the consignment shall be released after examining the phytosanitary status. Non-compliance for the second time shall be liable for a fine of daily minimum wage rate of 45 days for any consignment which is less than one truck load and minimum wage rate of 60 days for any consignment which is equivalent to a truck load or more. The consignment shall be seized and destroyed or transported back to the exporting country at the cost of the importer. Repeated offence for two or more times shall be liable for a fine of daily minimum wage of 90 days and the consignment shall be seized and auctioned
- 53. Without in-country movement permit for the movement of consignment from quarantine area with quarantine risk, a written warning shall be served for the first offence and the consignment shall be seized and destroyed. Repeated offences without incountry movement permit for two or more times shall be liable for a fine of daily minimum wage of 30 days and the consignment shall be seized and destroyed.

54. A person shall be deemed to commit a criminal offence of assault or battery under the Penal Code of Bhutan, 2004 (amendment 2011) who physically or verbally assaults an Inspector and such incident shall be reported immediately to the Royal Bhutan Police.

Any inspector shall be deemed to commit a criminal offence of assault or battery under the Penal Code of Bhutan, 2004 (amendment 2011) who physically or verbally assaults any person and such incident shall be reported immediately to the Royal Bhutan Police and such criminal penalization shall not preclude administrative actions as per Civil Service Act, 2011 and Bhutan Civil Service Rules and Regulations, 2018.
- 57. Any person including BAFRA officials, who alters, forges, counterfeits, defaces or destroys any certificates issued under the Act and these Rules shall be an offence punishable under the Penal Code of Bhutan, 2004 (amendment 2011).
- 58. A person who removes a plant, plant product, package, goods and soil that has been withheld as provided in Rule 10 of this Rules, without the written authority of an inspector shall be reported to the relevant authority for criminal prosecution under section 253 of Penal Code of Bhutan, 2004 (amendment 2011).

CHAPTER VII MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION

Amendment

59. The Ministry may amend the provisions of this Rule and the Schedules adopted thereunder as and when required.

Definitions

60. In addition to the definitions set out in Section 4 of Plant Quarantine Act of Bhutan 1993, for the purpose of this Rules, the following terms shall have the meaning ascribed to them hereunder;

SCHEDULE XV: Exemption for Wood Packaging Materials

- (4) Boxes for wine, cigars and other commodities made from wood that has been processed; and/or manufactured in a way that renders it free of pests;
- (5) Sawdust, wood shavings and wood wool; and wood components permanently attached to freight vehicles and containers.
