ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT (HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2025

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 77 of the Environmental Protection and Management Act 1999, the National Environment Agency, with the approval of the Minister for Sustainability and the Environment, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Environmental Protection and Management (Hazardous Substances) (Amendment No. 4) Regulations 2025 and come into operation on 1 January 2026.

Amendment of regulation 17

2. In the Environmental Protection and Management (Hazardous Substances) Regulations (Rg 4), in regulation 17 —

(a) replace paragraph (3) with —

“(3) A permit to store and use hazardous substances is valid for a period of 5 years starting from the date specified in the permit.”;

(b) in paragraph (4), replace sub-paragraph (a) with —

“(a) a fee of \$450 for a permit issued or renewed for a period of 5 years;”;

(c) in paragraph (4)(b), replace “\$110” with “\$180”.
