SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO FDA ADVISORY NO. 2025-0512

ENTITLED, "ON-BOARDING OF THE LICENSING PROCEDURES FOR HOUSEHOLD/URBAN HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES (HUHS) ESTABLISHMENTS ON THE FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION (FDA) ESERVICES PORTAL SYSTEM FOLLOWING DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH)

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2024-0015"** 

In light of the temporary disruptions due to data migration and on-boarding of the Household/Urban Hazardous Substances (HUHS) licensing renewal and variation modules to the FDA *eServices* Portal System, it is in the exigency of service that regulatory flexibilities in the issuance of *License-to-Operate* (LTO) for HUHS establishments be issued.

Thus, all previously-issued HUHSLTOs through the FDA e-Portal V2.0 system which expired or will be expiring before the completion of the data migration to the FDA eServices Portal System may be automatically renewed with waived surcharges, provided that, a "Letter of Request and Declaration Statement" is submitted to the Food and Drug Action Center (FDAC) through email at fdac.letters@fda.gov.ph.

Following the format of Annex G of FDA Advisory No. 2024-0543, which signifies intention to submit an LTO renewal application in the FDA eServices Portal System once available.

This flexibility shall stay in place until data migration is completed, or until otherwise declared.

This Advisory hereby temporarily supersedes the relevant provisions of FDA Advisory No. 2025-0512.
