

## Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA): Polyester Exempt under the 1984 Polymer Exemption Rule (EPA Flag Y2)

Special flags are used throughout the TSCA Inventory to identify substances on the Inventory that are subject of the EPA rule or order promulgated under TSCA, as well as to indicate types of full or partial exemptions from TSCA reporting requirements.

The flag for  $\underline{Y2}$  indicates a polymer that is a polyester and that was exempt under the 1984 polymer exemption rule. The polyester is made only from reactants included in a specified list of low-concern reactants that comprises one of the eligibility criteria for the 1984 polymer exemption rule.
